THE
CLERY ACT

The Jeanne Clery Campus Safety Act requires all colleges and universities receiving federal funding to gather, keep, and disclose information on specific crimes and hazing occurring on, or near, their campus.

The goal of the Clery Act is “to provide the campus community with timely, accurate and complete information about crime and the safety of campus so that they can make informed decisions to keep themselves safe.”

KU relies on Campus Security Authorities (CSAs) to report crimes in order to help keep campus safe.
